Once any nominee receives a majority of votes, the election is over. Council members are permitted to vote for themselves. The Mayor has no vote unless needed to break a tie.*

*The same procedure is followed for election of the vice-president.*

*Once both officers are elected, the president assumes the chair from the Mayor.*
